As you know, school uniform is not compulsory at Brindishe Green. ## **Brindishe Green Nursery**

We only have a few part time places left in our Nursery – these places are in the afternoon class. We offer 15 hours per week of high quality early years education and children aged 3 before 31 August 2019 are eligible for a September 2019 place. Please let your friends and neighbours know and ask them to contact the office team as soon as they can if they are interested.

## Collection arrangements for Ys 2 – 6
