#### Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

From September 2022, Universal Infant Free School Meals will come to an end for current Year 2 children. We will be holding 'drop in' sessions on **Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> June at 9.30am and 4pm** for anyone who may be eligible to claim for Free School Meals and who may need support with the application process. If you are not sure if you are eligible, please do pop along and we can offer support and guidance.

#### These sessions are not limited to Year 2 families, everybody is welcome!

For every successful FSM application, we will issue a £5 book voucher, a stationary set, and a school jumper for your child.

A successful application will also attract more funding for the school up to £1,345, which can be used towards Educational trips and visits, School activities, School equipment, Additional teaching and support staff, Extracurricular clubs and School counsellors. It's worth coming along!

#### Jubilee Day at Brindishe Lee



#### **Gardening Team**

The children have been very busy and having lots of fun over the last couple of weeks planting seeds, bulbs and plants. They have also been busy de-weeding and sowing seeds in the pots by the school entrance on Wantage Road and in the planters by the Lodge. We seem to have a group of children who love de-weeding!

The children have planted tomato plants which are now coming on very nicely. We measured them this week and they are nearing two foot tall, we expect to see an abundance of tomatoes in the coming weeks.

We also planted courgette seeds, onion bulbs and carrot seeds and we are already seeing shoots emerging from the planters.

This week the children planted herbs. The children got to choose which herbs they wanted to plant and we are hoping to see an array of mint, parsley and coriander in the near future.

After the half-term break we will be making clay ornaments and wind chimes which we will display in the courtyard area.
